
Summer saunters at Hucking Estate

There are plenty of picturesque picnic spots around Hucking Estate. The most impressive is beside our larger than life shepherd sculpture in the south of the site. Here you can enjoy the spectacular views across the Weald of Kent as you eat your lunch.



Find beautiful butterflies

Ancient woodland and open chalk grassland provide rich habitats for butterflies. Hucking Estate is home to 21 species, including the marbled white, silver washed fritillary and purple hairstreak. The latter is a rare butterfly that spends much of its time at the top of oak trees, feeding on aphid honeydew.
