
## Winter walks at Hucking Estate

and an impressive shepherd with his dog.



## Find the majestic beech tree

A huge beech tree, believed to be 200 years old, stands on an old field boundary next to the Woodland Trust car park. In winter months it is particularly striking, its bare branches standing out starkly against the sky.
