

FAUGHAN VALLEY WOODLANDS





Sculpture Loop
4.1 miles/6.6km | Strenuous | Allow 2 hours 50 minutes

Seek out the woodland sculptures dotted about the valley. From red deer to red campion, be sure to spot them all.

Loose gravel path with grassy sections which may be muddy seasonally. Frequent sets of steps, two bridge crossings and occasional steep sections.

🛑 River Path

2.3 miles/3.8km | Moderate | Allow 1 hour 30 minutes

Visit the fox and hare willow sculptures in Red Brae Wood then cross the bridge for a shorter ramble along the river. Watch out for the friendly kingfisher darting about the bank.

Loose gravel path with grassy sections which may be muddy seasonally. Mainly flat with some lengthy steep sections and steps in Red Brae Wood. One bridge crossing with sections of steps. Valley Trail 5.2 miles/8.5km | Strenuous | Allow 2 hours 50 minutes

A challenging but rewarding hike through the heart of the valley passing through an evolving landscape – from newly planted woodland to the bluebells of long established and ancient woodland.

Loose gravel paths with grassy sections which may be muddy seasonally. Frequent steps, two bridge crossings and lengthy steep sections. Access to Burntollet Wood and Brackfield Bawn Wood via underpass and single track road with occasional traffic.

The trails are not fully accessible for prams due to sections of steps and seasonally muddy and/or grassy paths. Please be aware that these trails are adjacent to a fast-flowing river which may flood. Children should always be supervised.
