

Are you ready to set sail?

1 Find a patch of ground with a tree and use sticks to outline the shape of your boat. The tree will be your mast, so keep it in the middle of your outline!

2 Build your ship around the tree then climb up the rigging into the crows nest and keep a look out for land.

3 Create a cabin with logs for seating, and use a leafy fallen branch to swab the decks.

4 Long branches make super oars that you can use to row your boat.

5 Sit on the edge of your boat and try to catch some fish. Scatter leaves in the 'sea' and pretend they're fish, then use sticks to catch them.

6 Discover an old map and set sail in search of long-lost treasure. Remember, X marks the spot!

Build your very own pirate ship using sticks and branches, then set sail through the trees and search for buried treasure.

Use your imagination and turn your boat into a pirate's galleon or a Viking longship!
