You'll need:

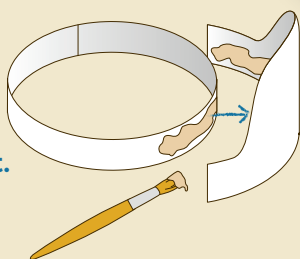
- Scissors

Carefully cut out the hat template. Ask your grown-up to help.

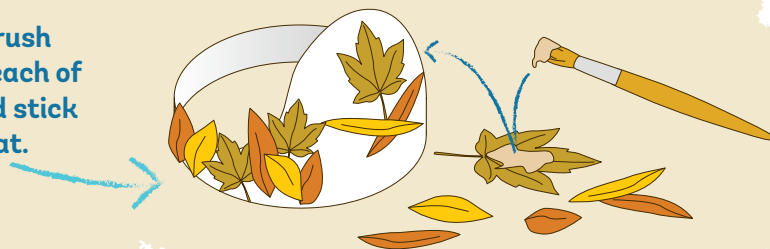
