



Fat maggots

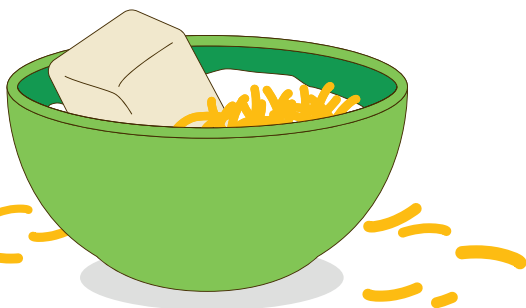
Create a scrummy feast for your garden visitors

You will need:

- 80g plain flour
- 30g lard
- Mild, grated cheese

1



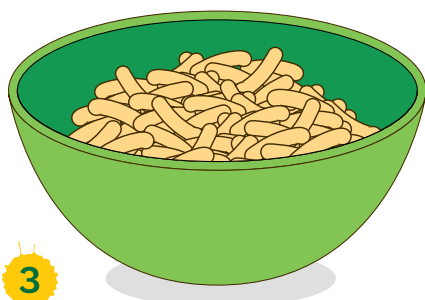
Put the flour, cheese and lard into a bowl.

Mash the ingredients together. Create maggot-shaped pieces by rolling little bits between your finger and thumb.

Once it's turned into little maggot-like pieces, it's ready.

Pop the maggots on your bird table or in your garden. Who's tucking in?



Remember to remove food from bird tables before it goes mouldy or it could make birds ill.

Carry on feeding the birds once you start; they rely on it and go hungry without it.
