

Langley Vale Wood Month of Remembrance

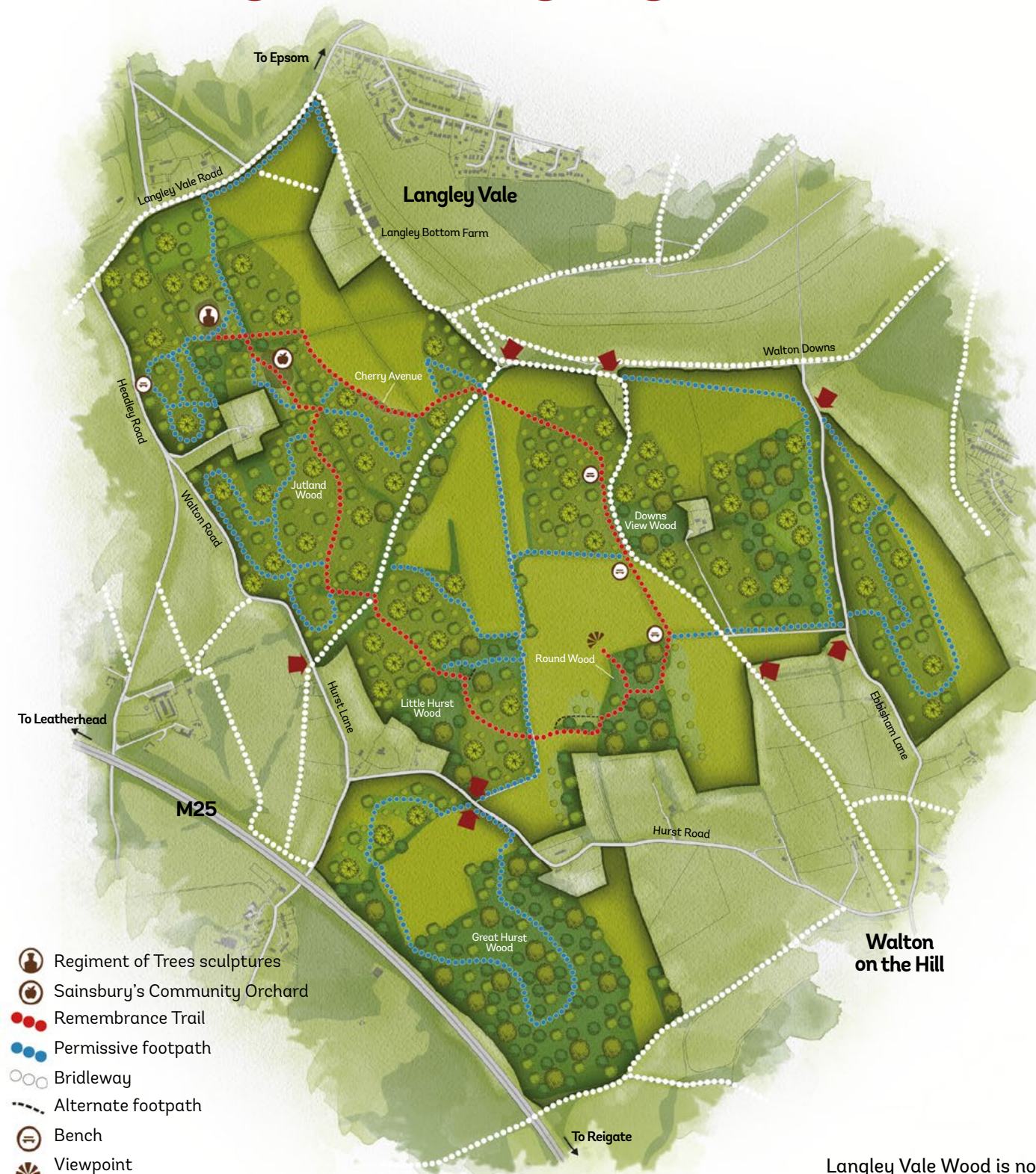
Commemorating the end of the First World War
