A scenic trail between two historic landmarks passing through the magnificent Nidd Gorge, part of the ancient Knaresborough Forest.

● **Castle to Castle Walk** 10.4km / 6.5 miles | Moderate | Allow 4 hours

A scenic walk linking two historic castles, a section of the Niddedale Greenway and the paths along the southern bank of the River Nidd.

A variety of paths from wide and flat tarmac of the Niddedale Greenway to some narrow paths with sections of boardwalk, steps and stiles. Some sections can get very muddy after wet weather and the riverside paths can get flooded after prolonged heavy rain.
