We recognise the contribution that ex-offenders can make as volunteers and welcome applications from them. A person's criminal record will not, in itself, debar that person from being appointed to this role. Suitable applicants will not be refused a role because of offences which are not relevant to, and do not place them at or make them a risk in, the role for which they are applying.

All cases will be examined on an individual basis and will take the following into consideration:

- Whether the conviction is relevant to the position applied for
- The seriousness of any offence revealed
- The age of the applicant at the time of the offence(s)
- The length of time since the offence(s) occurred
- Whether the applicant has a pattern of offending behaviour
- The circumstances surrounding the offence(s) and the explanation(s) offered by the person concerned
- Whether the applicant's circumstances have changed since the offending behaviour

It is important that applicants understand that failure to disclose all unspent convictions could result in being asked to leave the role.

This role is not exempt from the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974. We only ask applicants to disclose convictions which are not yet spent under the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974. We are not asking you to declare any spent convictions. If you are unsure whether your conviction is spent or unspent please follow the link [gov.uk](https://www.gov.uk) (or [mygov.scot](https://www.mygov.scot) for Scotland) for further information.

Those applicants that do have unspent convictions will be contacted for more details to enable an assessment on the above criteria before commencing any volunteering role.
